It is great to see work under way with the changes to Dame Mary Gilmour Road. Council contractors were hoping to be finished by the time we were due back at school however are running a bit behind due to the rain.



Council were first approached about this project not long after I first started at OWPS as Principal in 2008. I approached the parking situation again some years later as the school was increasing in numbers and parking around the school was getting quite heavy during the busy pick up and drop off times. There has also been a noticeable increase in the use of Oatley Park during this time.



There should be parking for around another 20 cars, improvements to the intersection into Oatley Park and a pathway into the park which will allow the staff and students to get to the park via our back gate. It's great to see this project nearing completion.

REMINDERS

A few reminders to 'kick off' the term:

- All teaching staff 'entry on duty' is from 8.55am.
 Morning duty commences at this time.
- It is a requirement that your child should be at school every school day. If absences occur, the Home School Liaison Officer may contact you. Holidays during school time are not encouraged by the department and overseas trips need to be approved by the principal.
- Your classroom teacher should be the first person contacted if you have concerns about your child. This can be escalated to the Stage Supervisor (Assistant Principal), if you feel you have not had your question answered.
- Teachers are very busy people. We have three timetabled school morning meetings each week. Individual Stages have other meetings at various times. If you need to see a teacher please ring the office to make an appointment. They will ensure you are connected with your teacher at the earliest convenience. It is good practice to let the secretary have a summary of the meeting you require so that the teacher can be prepared for you.
- We are very conscious of security and our gates are closed (approximately) at 9.25am as the children head off to class. The gates are re-opened again at 3.15pm. These are approximate times. Entry and exit to the school is then via the single gate at the administration building in Oatley Park Avenue. You will need to buzz the intercom for entry or exit. On assembly days the gate will



be opened once in time for you to make your way to the school hall, once all students have been seated. We thank you for your patience in this matter.

There will be a combined rehearsal for Intermediate Band and Concert Band on Thursday 18th October. Please arrive at school at 7.50am.


