Winter Uniform: Winter Uniform is not yet available for over the counter sales and is not worn until the day after Mother's Day (14th May). In the interim, we are encouraging all parents to place a separate order for winter uniform. Orders placed will be given priority prior to winter uniform going on sale over the counter.

At this stage, only 5% of pre-winter orders have been received. With almost 600 students at the school, Uniform Shop cannot guarantee stock availability if your order is not placed in advance. Some stock items can take between 8-12 weeks to arrive.

NB: Accounts for these orders will not debited and cheques not presented until stock arrives and is ready for delivery.

Stock Update: We are still waiting for Boys Size 9-12 boy's socks to arrive. Orders for this item will be placed on backorder and delivered to your child's class when stock arrives.

Unisex Sport Shorts: These shorts are currently being sold to all girls and Kindy students. Boys requiring Size 6 Sport Shorts will also be sold the new shorts. All other sizes in Boys Sport Shorts will continue to be sold until all stock is sold.

Uniform Orders: Order forms (dated January, 2018) can be completed and dropped in to the school office. All orders will be delivered to your child's classroom on Thursday when the shop is open. The preferred payment method for orders is by credit card or cheque.

Going online: commbank.com.au/schoolbanking

Visiting a branch: visit a Commonwealth Bank branch with identification for yourself and your child, like a driver's licence and birth certificate.

At School: On the above date a School Banking representative will be available at the Information Session to show you how you can do this. You will need to bring your driver's licence and your child's birth certificate.

Existing Youthsaver: If your child has an existing Commonwealth Bank Youthsaver account they can start banking straight away. They just need to bring their Dollarmites deposit wallet.
