

On Friday four produce beds were cleared with a cover crop to go in this week, readying the garden for student activity in the near future. Later this week the four remaining beds will be cleared for the same purpose.

The native plant project looks set to go ahead in the coming holidays, with the existing bush tucker site receiving a more intensive planting, a second bush tucker site being established, an arbouring and mulching of the citrus grove and various patches of invasive weeds being removed from around the school. SPORTS NEWS



Update - Representative school sport/3-6 PSSA/3-6 Athletics Carnival

Please see below the main points from Sydney East regarding sport continuation

- As noted on the School Sport Unit website and the Sydney East Facebook, I can confirm that all school sport representative pathway activities have been cancelled for 2020 due to the difficulties associated with coordinating these events. These include Swimming, Athletics and Cross Country at the Sydney East and NSWPSSA/NSWCHSSA levels. These also include team sports such as Basketball, Rugby League, Rugby Union etc, where there is a defined pathway through to state carnivals where students need to be selected based on merit, to move to the next stage.
- In regard to zone/district activities, it is up to each district as to whether major district carnivals such as Cross Country and Athletics will occur. At this stage we have not received information as to whether the Georges River District Athletics carnival will go ahead.
- Based on this information, Oatley West Public School <u>will not</u> be having their Official Athletics Carnival at Barden Ridge in Term 3. We are in the process of looking at in school opportunities for students to be involved in sport. In the event we are informed that the Georges River District Athletics Carnival will go ahead, we will hold in-school trials to select students. We are still awaiting information regarding these carnivals. There will be no pathway to progress to Sydney East or NSWPSSA/NSWCHSSA carnivals as they have been cancelled. The Georges River PSSA district are currently in discussion on how PSSA will go ahead. At this stage, we have been provided options as to how this will look, with it seeming positive and probable that some form of PSSA sport will occur next term.

The effects of the global COVID-19 pandemic have been felt throughout the education community, and many difficult choices have been made that have had significant impacts on schools and students.

Schools have not had the opportunity to organise their stage of the trials process. Consequently, the representative pathway at the Association and State levels cannot be conducted in terms three (3) and four (4) of the school year.

It is not possible for schools to rearrange activities at this stage of the year given limitations with venue availability and rescheduling the many educational and sporting events on a school calendar. Additionally, current NSW Government guidelines do not allow for large scale events to be held where crowds will be in attendance.

The national body, School Sport Australia, recognised this issue and officially cancelled all national events for 2020 at the conclusion of term one.

We understand your disappointment and concerns in not being able to participate in these programs during COVID-19 restrictions in 2020. We thank you for your support and understanding.
