ees' comments, which confirmed her expertise and capacity to lead and manage Peakhurst South Public School in the role of Principal. Neralie will take up this appointment on 10th August 2020 (Week 4, Term 3) which means this is her last week at Oatley West with Friday being her last day at our school.

Neralie has been with the school for 5 1/2 years commencing in 2015. During her time here she led the school through the Validation Process and many major whole school programs including the development of the 2015-2017 and 2018-2020 School Plans, Milestones and Annual Reports; led the school through improving reading through the Focus on Reading Program; introduced collaborative planning, formative assessment and differentiated curriculum across the school and effectively structured, developed and supported the implementation of the Quality Teaching Successful Students (QTSS) initiative to name a few of her instructional leadership pursuits.

Neralie's organisational ability was not lost in her management of the St George Performing Arts Festival (SPAF) as Concert Director each year overseeing and delivering the organisation and running of six concerts including 22 schools in the area of performing arts.

Neralie also attained further study during this time completing the Aspiring Leadership Credential and contributed to the NSW Deputy Principal's Network supporting deputy principals in quality, relevant professional learning and networking opportunities.
